Dear WNDA Member,

Welcome to our 2008 tour year. Our Annual Membership Meeting was held December 8, 2007 in Atlantic City. The major discussions and accomplishments of the meeting are listed below.

- The Governing Body started the meeting with “what we did right, what we did wrong, and what we could have done better”. This conversation allows for a self-examination of the year completed and a new outlook for the coming year.
- The minutes of the General Membership meeting, Governing Body meeting and Governing Body Election Meeting held at the Grand Prix event were reviewed and approved.
- 2007 End-of-Year-Finances were reviewed and approved.
- The 2008 Budget was reviewed and approved.
- The 2008 Tour Schedule was reviewed and approved.
- The Governing Body agreed to purchase a “go-phone” with a loadable phone card whereby messages regarding the tour cuts and roll-off information could be stored. Members will be able to call the number and hear the recording once the information has been finalized at each stop. The phone number will be provided to everyone at the first stop of the season and posted on the web site.
- During the Annual Membership Meeting, the members of the tour discussed fundraising. The members unanimously voted that in addition to the lottery ticket sales, that they would prefer selling raffle tickets for cash drawings as compared to selling raffle tickets for merchandise. The members asked that the Governing Body come up with something new. The Governing Body listened! At our Hagerstown stop this year each member will receive twenty (20) raffle tickets to be sold at a price of \$10.00 each. Members will be asked to sell a minimum of 10 tickets each. Associate members will also be given the opportunity to participate. Additional tickets will be available from Vicki Kramer. All tickets, stubs, and unsold tickets will be due at our July stop at Westview. The member selling the most tickets will receive \$250.00. Twelve monthly drawings will be held, commencing in September, where the winner of each drawing will receive \$250.00. Winning in one month will not preclude the winner from winning a second time, as their stub will be re-entered into the pool. Winners will be posted on our web-site. If every member sells only 10 tickets, the tour will make a \$5,000 profit.

Enclosed are the Member Application, Advertising Form and Adopt-a-Bowler Form.

- Member Application: Please review the Member Application carefully, complete all information and sign the form where indicated. ALL MEMBERS MUST SUBMIT A MEMBER APPLICATION PRIOR TO BOWLING IN THEIR FIRST EVENT. There are no exceptions.
- Advertising Form: The Advertising Form may be used for two purposes.
 - (1) Members may still BOWL FOR FREE! Should a member have a sponsor willing to contribute \$175 for one half-page ad in each of six program books, the member will receive a \$40 credit toward their annual membership dues. Should a member have a sponsor willing to contribute \$250 for one half-page ad in each of six program books and an advertisement and/or link to their website on the WNDA web site, the member will receive a \$75 credit toward their annual membership dues.

For each additional sponsor, at any level, the member will receive a credit equal to the entry fee of a tour stop (to include the Grand Prix). Members may submit up to seven sponsors per year, providing themselves with credits for their membership fees and each tour stop. Credits must be used during the current tour season and will not forward into the following year. Should you obtain an advertiser prior to the deadline for submitting your member application, please enclose the completed form with the advertiser's check made payable to the WNDA with your application. If the sponsorship is for \$175, please enclose a personal check for the balance of your membership fees. If the sponsorship is for \$250, no fee from the member is required. Sponsors may be obtained at any time during the year.
 - (2) As in the past, the form may also be used for one-time advertisements in our tour books.
- Adopt-a-Bowler Form: The Adopt-a-Bowler Form is to be used by members wishing to introduce the tour to new bowlers. WNDA members will receive a \$5.00 credit for each Adopt-A-Bowler they sign up to bowl in an event. If the bowler then joins the tour, the WNDA member will receive a \$20.00 credit.

Please submit your Member Application and Advertising Form, if applicable, with your check made payable to the WNDA to the WNDA Statistician, 483 South Hills Court, Westminster, MD 21158. **Bowlers wishing to participate in the first event of the year in Hagerstown, MD should submit their applications no later than April 25, 2008. Bowlers submitting their applications by April 15, 2008 will receive a \$5.00 credit.**
