Phillips Wins Second Consecutive Pro Tour Title

BALTIMORE, Maryland, September 12, 2011—Susan Phillips of Preston, Maryland, won her second consecutive WNSA title at the Pro Tour held at Pinland Bowl in Dundalk. Phillips had the third highest qualifying score with 1155 in the 8-game round on Saturday. She went 5 – 0 with a total of 722 in the semi-finals on Sunday to earn the top spot on the ladder for the finals. In the finals, she defeated Canadian Connie Ward with an outstanding 193 game to Ward's 144. Ward was the high qualifier on Saturday with 1189, then went 4 – 1 with 772 in the semi-finals.

The top 5 finishers at the Pinland Bowl event were: #1 Susan Phillips (Preston, MD), #2 Connie Ward (Ontario, CANADA), #3 Jill Sachs (Sykesville, MD), #4 Kristi Lampman (Ontario, CANADA), and #5 Mindy Thomas (Glenn Dale, MD). Full details are on the [WNSA Web site](#).

This is Phillips second consecutive win, having being victorious at the Pro Tour event at Town Hall Lanes in Johnston, Rhode Island in August. Her only other championship came in 1987, her rookie year on the pro tour. The three-time winner gives a lot of credit to her husband, Bobby, for all of his support throughout her career.

Phillips leads the race for the 2011 WNSA Bowler of the Year Award with 387 points, but Ward is right behind her with 363, followed by Lampman with 341. The final event of the 2011 Pro Tour season, the Grand Prix Invitational, will be held on November 5-6 at AMF Timonium in Baltimore, Maryland. The event is open to the viewing public free of charge.

It has held more than 150 events with over \$1 million in prizes and awards.
