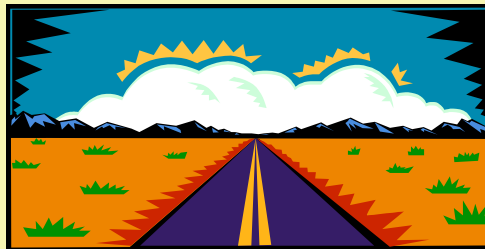

In the end, the game and the day went to Lauree who won the match and the star, 158-127. Overall, Lauree averaged 146 for the weekend.

I want to thank my husband, Danny for waking Trevor up from his nap to get to Glen Burnie to watch the final match. The fact that you and Trevor were there to support me means the world to me. She was a lady both on and off the lanes and was well respected by everyone who made her acquaintance. This annual award is given to the WNSA member who best exemplifies the qualities that Ann brought to the game: good sportswomanship, dedication, and unselfish devotion to the game of duckpins and to her fellow bowlers.

Theresa, also devoted to the game of duckpins, served as the Treasurer for the WNSA for over twenty years, as President of the NDBC for three years, and on the Board of the NDBC for over 20 years. She also served in local and state duckpin associations. Theresa was elected to the BAC Hall of Fame in 1996 and 2006 and to the WNSA Hall of Fame in 2003. This annual award is given to the WNSA member who best personifies the spirit of Theresa Belniak's service commitment to the WNSA. Theresa dedicated her time, efforts, expertise, and her heart to make the WNSA a successful organization. Each year the winner of this award will have shown their dedication to the tour, either in the past or in the present, by lending their time, their ideas, and their efforts to the success of the WNSA.

Anyone may nominate a WNSA member to receive these awards.

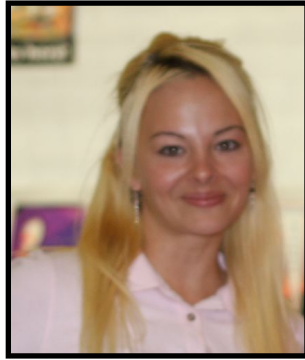

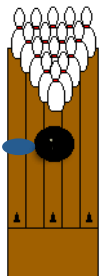

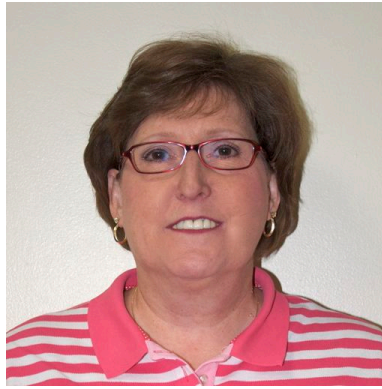

**REFERENCE THE WNSA BY-LAWS, ARTICLE II-A, STRUCTURE.**

Interested parties must submit a resume delineating bowling background and qualifications for the position.
