Our opening event at Dual Lanes in Hagerstown has just wrapped up. The word on the street is that the weekend was a great time for a lot of the bowlers. The second tour stop of the 2011 season will be held on June 18th & 19th at Johnson's Lanes in Hamden, Connecticut. The entry fee for this event is \$80.00. There will be two qualifying shifts held on Saturday, June 18th, at 8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their shift time. It is the bowler's responsibility to be there on time to avoid a penalty. Shift assignments will be made on a first-come, first-served basis using the entry's postmark. The semi-finals will start at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday. The Governing Body will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday at Johnson's.

Please complete the attached tournament entry form and return it to the WNSA statistician at the address on the form. Please do not return it to the WNSA office. To provide shift information in a timely manner, entry forms must be postmarked no later than Wednesday, June 8, 2011. Entries postmarked after this date will incur a \$10 late fee. Decisions and commitments are made based on the number of entries we have in advance of the event, so it is important to get your entries in early.

Would you like to take home an extra \$100.00? Of course you would. We are fortunate to have a very generous anonymous donor who sponsors a \$100 cash drawing at each tour stop. All WNSA bowlers competing at this event are eligible for the drawing.

Johnson's is a very nice bowling center and has hosted the WNSA a number of times over the years.
