Dear WNSA Member or Interested Bowler,

The next pro tour event in our 2011 season will be held at Pinland Bowl in Dundalk, MD, over the Labor Day weekend. It will consist of two qualifying rounds on Saturday, September 3 and the semi-finals and ladder finals on Sunday, September 4. We strongly urge you to tell your friends, neighbors, and colleagues about the event so we can build our spectator and fan base. This really helps with sponsors and as we are able to add sponsors, it will take pressure off of the fundraising efforts.

At Pinland Bowl, we have **scheduled two shifts on Saturday at 8:30 a.m. and at 1:30 p.m.** This allows us to accommodate all of our membership. Entries need to be postmarked by Tuesday, August 23rd. As our last standard event of the tour season, it is also an excellent time to invite others to enter as Adopt-A-Bowlers. This continues to be a terrific way for women to try competing on the tour without the membership commitment.

Anyone desiring to qualify for an invitation to the Grand Prix Invitational will need to bowl in at least one event in the Maryland/DC/Virginia area and one in the New England area (CT or RI). If you have not yet bowled in Maryland, this is your final opportunity to meet the requirement.
